Dear Mr. Principal:

I know you are always concerned with providing the best possible learning environment, instruction, materials, and equipment for our students. This letter is to introduce you to a powerful new tool for student learning.

The MelodyWave[®] Instrument is the latest development in music technology. It is a wireless electronic musical instrument designed to give students the capacity to perform and learn music using over 256 instrument sounds. Students use up to 49 wireless batons to create sounds and music. When connected to the music room sound system, it can produce sound soft enough to sound like a chamber ensemble or loud enough to fill the football stadium with the strains of the National Anthem.

Its size and portability make it adaptable for the regular classroom, gymnasium, or community performance venues. The cases of batons are durable, lightweight, and easy to carry. When setup is required, you simply plug the MelodyWave[®] Instrument in to a sound module and sound system and it is ready to use. It can be set up as a lab for music instruction, taken into a theatre to provide sound effects for a dramatic performance, or used to provide music for a PTA meeting. It can also be used in a classroom to enhance the reading of a story or poem. Its applications are numerous.

As is the case with many musical instruments, the MelodyWave[®] Instrument does carry a significant price tag. I believe the learning opportunities it can create for students are well worth investing the time and effort to acquire the necessary funds.
